Many people are attracted to sports because they like watching the amazing athletic abilities of the players, who must train hard in order to achieve success. \_\_\_\_\_\_ competition is expected to occur on a level playing field, there have been some athletes who have used drugs to gain an unfair advantage.

Cheating in sports, particularly the use of performance-enhancing drugs (PEDs), has gotten more public attention recently because the number of high-profile athletes who have been caught has increased. Many sports leagues simply don't have adequate testing resources, compelling athletes to make a choice: take PEDs or stay clean and play against those who do take the drugs.

The men's 100-meter final at the 1988 Summer Olympics in Seoul is an example of how widespread doping is. In that race, Canada's Ben Johnson set a world record. Afterwards, Johnson failed his PED test, and his gold medal was taken away. Later in their careers, the second- and third-place finishers, Carl Lewis and Linford Christie, also tested positive for PEDs. Eventually, six of the eight men in that final were caught cheating.

Cycling is another sport notorious for cheating. Lance Armstrong, who famously defeated cancer and later won seven Tour de France titles, is the biggest star to have been caught. Many believed he'd be the last guy to cheat, but in 2013 he admitted to using PEDs. He is now banned from competition for life.

What kind of message does cheating in sports send to the next generation of athletes? A recent study on cheating found that 90 percent of young athletes felt pressure to win, and over one-third of them would not feel bad to win by cheating. Clearly, the message

that cheating is wrong has not gotten through.

There are some who may want glory by cheating their way to the top. They should remember that if they get caught, everything they have worked for will be lost and they will forever be branded as a cheater.

In most places in the world today, it is easy to find healthy food. With supermarkets, buying healthy food like fresh fruits, vegetables, fish and meat is easy and convenient. However, it is also easy to find unhealthy food today. Supermarkets and other stores sell good food, but they also sell frozen foods and junk food, like chips, candy, and cookies. A lot of food today contains chemicals. Research has shown that many of these chemicals are bad for our health. So did people in the past eat healthier than we do today?

A century ago, people didn't eat junk food or frozen food. Instead, they ate natural foods without chemicals. \_\_\_\_\_\_, their natural foods were not always as good as food today. In the past, meat often came from sick animals. It's not healthy to eat meat from a sick animal. In most places today, laws make sure that food is safe.

In most countries today, we can buy a variety of foods. We can buy oranges in the winter and apples in the summer. Healthy fruits and vegetables are available at any time of year. These foods come from all over the world. In the past, this kind of variety was not possible. People could eat certain foods only in certain seasons.

We eat much more meat, sugar, fattening foods, and chemicals today than people did a century ago. Studies show that these things can cause heart disease and a variety of other health problems. However, people live much longer now. Today, the average person lives for 70 to 80 years. In contrast, 100 years ago, the average person lived for only about 50 years. People live longer because we have better medicine now. But people also have longer lives because healthy food is almost always available.

So did people eat healthier in the past? Yes and no. People in the past did eat more natural food than we do now. But, in some ways, we eat better today. We can eat healthier today than people did in the past. We just have to choose to eat good foods.
