Checking in, also known as "geotagging," has become very popular. Using check-in services, such as those offered by Facebook, Yelp, and Foursquare, people can let friends know whenever they visit a restaurant, shop, or landmark.

Where are people checking in? Some of the locations with the most check-ins are New York's Times Square, a nightclub in Russia, and the Tokyo Dome. Many other sports stadiums and concert venues also made the most-popular list.

Many smartphone users are taking advantage of the benefits that checking in provides.

, some stores will offer you a discount for checking in, and you might even be offered a free drink or side dish through a restaurant's program.

Although millions of smartphone users enjoy checking in online, some are concerned that it poses safety risks. For example, some criminals have been reported to plan robberies by using location services to learn when a person is away from home. What's more, even if you've said no to geotagging, you may still be participating in it because some services allow users to check in their friends without permission. Clearly, safety and privacy are concerns to take seriously when it comes to using a check-in service.

In the end, the control of private information is in each person's hands. With the right safety settings in place, checking in can provide a fun, positive way to save money and interact with friends online.
